

We're looking for somebody who can create high quality, imaginative, engaging and adventurous videos and content that is suitable for our social media channels.

You'll be able to build your personal creative portfolio whilst immersing yourself in the way we work. You will learn the correct ways of working with children and young people, including the understanding of why policies, procedures and safeguarding is so important, especially when in regards to photography and videography.

WHAT'S INVOLVED?

We are looking for somebody who's able to come along to key performances and events throughout 2019/2020 and capture special Sound Pop Academy moments, such as performances and other events.

You'll then use this footage for creating social media campaigns, but also to collate and edit for our end of year video., which will be produced and edited by you.

You need to be able to use your own digital editing software, own a high quality camera and be prepared to be available at a number of gigs throughout the year as well as some academy sessions to capture a range of activity. It is a creative role where the more you put in, the more you'll get out. We're looking for someone who is energetic, engaging, a self starter and experimental.



WHAT YOU'LL ACHIEVE

As well as invaluable hands on experience and videos for your professional portfolio, once you have completed our programme we will award you with a **Resident Videographer** certificate which you can take to job interviews, use for other work placements and hopefully give you that step on the ladder to a successful career. You'll also be able to use this programme and the content you create as experience on your CV.

HOW TO APPLY

If you would like to apply for our **Resident Videographer** Programme, you must meet the following criteria;

- Be aged 16 to 25. If you're aged 18 and above, you must hold or be able to obtain a clean DBS.
- Have parental / guardian permission to apply if under 18
- Be able to travel to different performances / events around Southampton / Winchester / Port Solent
